

2019-20 Parade Sign Up

Parade Details:

These parades are incredibly important to our mission and the fundraising efforts for the Summit Dance Fund that directly funds your dancer's dance education.

While at these parades, your dancer is representing our studio and our community. It is incredibly important that you are on time and as professional as possible.

Please re-read the detailed instructions below if you have any questions. If you still have questions after reading the information, then please give us a call or respond to this email.

Where, When, Attire:

Dancers meet Wendy from Keystone at Kidtopia headquarters at **3:30 pm**, they CANNOT be late! Kidtopia is next to the ice rink in River Run. If you are standing by the ice rink looking at the mountain, Kidtopia headquarters is on your right. If you feel comfortable dropping them off you can drive right into Idabelle Dr and pull up either by the ice rink or right in front of the Kidtopia building. Otherwise, you can park in the large River Run lot and walk over. If you are parking (especially during the holidays) please leave extra time to find a spot and make the trek to Kidtopia.

Dancers should wear black pants. Any solid black pants are fine, as long as they are in good shape. No holes in the knees, etc... if it's a cold day I recommend black snow pants, or multiple layers. They should also wear boots they can dance in (not ski or snowboarding boots).

Dancers can wear any jacket they like to arrive, they will change in the locker room into a Keystone jacket for the parade, then they change back into their own coat before they leave (the Keystone jacket stays behind in the locker room for next time). Dancers are also provided with Keystone hats and gloves for the parade if it is a cold day.

They will be ready to be picked up at 4:30 back at Kidtopia headquarters.

ADULT SUPERVISION REQUIRED (Wendy is our Supervisor):

Wendy is responsible for supervising dancers at the parades, and walking them back and forth from Kidtopia to the parade route. Dancers MUST be on time to be part of this supervised group. As our group consists of minors, this is a requirement Keystone has set for us, and I appreciate it. Dancers will not be permitted to wander around Keystone by themselves during parade hours. This is a group

commitment, and all dancers must be on time to be part of the group. If a dancer is late to the check in they will not be counted as part of the group and this is a contract violation for them.

ADA staff is not responsible for supervising dancers at the parades, for scheduling parade dates, for dancing in the parades, or for getting parade shifts covered. In fact, we are rarely present for the parades at all. We trust Wendy and the Keystone team to supervise, and the Vibes to do their part as performers.

These parades are an important commitment for the Vibes, and every team member pulls their weight to get the parade contract fulfilled. Each dancer is responsible for a 6 parade commitment (some signed up for as many as 10 - WOW!!!). This 6 parade minimum was included in their contracts. The money they get paid goes to the Summit Dance Fund. This fund is a necessity to our dancers and our program, most of our team received \$545 in SDF scholarship funds just this year!

GETTING PARADES COVERED:

In the event that a dancer is sick, she is the one that needs to get her shift covered as soon as she knows she cannot participate. Do NOT call or text people 10 minutes before the parade to get a shift covered, at that point you may have to suck it up and go dance for 4 minutes. As soon as you start feeling sick start reaching out to your team. All the dancers phone numbers are posted at the studio, (we will not be posting them online), and they should all have each others contact info in their phones. Parents of our younger dancers, this task sometimes does fall to you. It is not the responsibility of the other girls (who are already there) to frantically try and cover a shift if someone does not show up at 3:30.

Also, please check the calendar before asking for coverage. You might not want to text the girls that are already dancing that day, unless you want a bunch of responses saying "I'm already doing the parade that day." If you switch a day, or get a parade covered, it is your responsibility to e-mail that switch to alpinedancevibes@gmail.com . We will then put those changes onto the master sign up sheet and post it online for all to reference.

REMINDERS:

We know some of you signed up for these parades a LONG time ago, so each Monday we send out a parade reminder to all the dancers participating that Saturday. Look for that reminder to be sure of your

dates, and you can always check the online sign up sheet (link above) at any time. Again, we will do our best to make sure any switches get put on the master online sign up sheet.

THIS IS A JOB:

These shifts are exactly like a Job - for example, the shifts each dancer signs up for are her "work" days (like working a Friday night shift every week at a restaurant). Covering for another dancer is great, and is a necessity for a commitment like this to work (like picking up a Tuesday night shift for someone at the restaurant). However, picking up a parade for someone else does not excuse you from any of the parades you signed up for (that would be like not showing up for your normally scheduled Friday night shift.)

These parades are really fun for the girls and it's a huge opportunity for them to be ambassadors for Keystone. They are being treated the same as adult employees (apart from the fact that they need adult supervision), so it's super important that they are punctual and professional at all times.

We need at least 8 dancers for each of the following parade dates, and a maximum of 12:
