COVID-19 Guideline quick reference for ADA classes

Masks must be worn at all times.

Class sizes may not exceed 25 students at any time, excluding staff.

Dressing room and restrooms are limited to 2 students at a time.

Parents may not enter basement area of The Frisco Center for pick up or drop off. Dancers may be dropped off at front or back building doors. Parents who would like to request an escort for their dancer may call the studio from the curb and a staff member will pickup/deliver dancer between the car and the studio. Parents will only be welcome to enter with an appointment and may only stay for the duration of the appointment. This excludes Pre-K Parents, who are welcome to deliver dancer to studio door for drop off and pick-up only. **No parents, students or community members are welcome in the Frisco Center common areas during ADA hours of operation.**

Students may not attend class if exhibiting any symptoms of sickness, parents should assess symptoms at home before allowing dancers to attend class.

Students who do not feel well during class will have temperature taken with a forehead wand (no physical contact). Students who develop a fever during class time will be sent home and will not be welcome back to class until one of the following conditions is met:

- Negative test result (if they haven't tested positive in the last 10 days or been in close contact with someone who tested positive)
- An alternate diagnosis from a medical provider (in which case they would follow exclusion for that diagnosis)
- A previously disclosed diagnosis (ex. coughing because of asthma or diarrhea and headache because of menstruation)
- Exclude for 10 days +24 hours fever free

Should a positive case be confirmed in an ADA community member the studio will close for cleaning and cohort who was in contact with the infected individual will need to quarantine for 14 days before returning to class. No refunds will be given for tuition in the event of sickness or quarantine. Please be mindful of mask wearing and social distancing (even outside the studio) at all times to protect each other and our ability to operate.
